
LET'S GO...OUT TO PLAY! FOR EARLY YEARS

227 children and 41 practitioners from 8 early years settings participated in Out to Play in a Day sessions in February and March 2025. 25 nursery practitioners completed a Pre-Project Questionnaire and 19 filled out a Post-Project Questionnaire. A selection of the highlight statistics have been included in this short report.

How would you rate your confidence levels in utilising drama within your practice? (25 pre- & 19 post- respondents)



Which elements of Out to Play In a Day do you feel were beneficial to you? (19 respondents)

- Having the Drama Artist working in our setting, so we could see how our outdoor space could be used in different/new creative ways (19)
- Having the time to try out activities during the CPD session (16)
- Being given new ideas for outdoor creative arts activities (15)
- Seeing the Drama Artist working directly with the children (14)

How did the children at your nursery benefit from participating in Out to Play In a Day? (19 respondents)

- Increased confidence (18)
- Enjoyment/having fun (18)
- Opportunity to use imagination (18)
- Opportunity to be creative (18)

- Drama skills (17)
- Storytelling skills (16)
- Outdoor play skills (13)
- Nature-based learning skills (12)
